

2019-2020 Difficulty Scoring Rubric Pom

COMPLEXITY OF MOVEMENT RUBRIC

Movements that a minimum of 75% of the team execute as well as the entire piece of choreography, from start to finish, is taken into consideration.

A movement is defined as motions choreographed to create visuals, transitions between formations, use of the floor, and footwork.

DIFFICULTY

0 - 4 points

Stationary one or two count movements
Routine stays mostly center
Dancers walk to each formation
Transitions take **one 8-count** to occur
Choreography does not blend throughout

5 – 8 points

Stationary one count movements
Routine moves up/down floor, but stays center
Dancers walk or run to each formation
Transitions take **four - eight counts** to occur
Some choreography blends throughout

9 - 12 points

Stationary one count movement with footwork
Routine moves throughout entire floor
Dancers have choreography to each formation
Transitions take **four counts** to occur
Choreography blends throughout

13 - 15 points

Shifting "and counts" movement with footwork
Routine moves throughout entire floor
Dancers have choreography to each formation
Transitions take less than **four counts** to occur
Choreography seamlessly blends throughout
