## 1) Meetings

- a) This committee will meet two or three times each year.
- b) We need to look globally across the state; see the big picture
  - i) Decisions will be by consensus
  - ii) Refer recommendations to the AIA Executive Board for action
  - iii) The committee may suggest changes for soccer and have those submitted to the Executive Board, regions or conferences. Regions and Conferences may still initate changes for sports.

### 2) Divisions

- a) Created based upon school enrollment numbers submitted last week
- b) Executive Board will approve the Divisions at the Oct. 18<sup>th</sup> meeting
- c) Appeal Process Schools may appeal division placement Oct. 19<sup>th</sup> Oct. 25<sup>th</sup>
- d) Sports Advisory committees will hear appeals Oct. 25<sup>th</sup> 29<sup>th</sup>
  - i) Conference calls may be used for appeals
- e) AIA Executive Board will look at criteria for the appeals process
  - i) Appeals criteria will be consistent across all sports and divisions
  - ii) Apepals will be for the next two year block
