Send complete results (swimming and diving) for your region tournament to the designated State Meet Computer Administrator immediately following the meet, no later than 8:00 PM on Saturday, October 23 for 4A, and no later than 8:00 PM on Saturday, October 30 for 5A. ## DURING THE MEET - RULES

- Rules shall be those of the current edition of the National Federation Swimming/Diving, the AIA Constitution and Bylaws and these tournament instructions.
- A.S.U. prohibits food and drinks on the pool deck. Do not plan to bring coolers filled with food and drinks on the deck. NO GLASS containers may be brought on the pool deck.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Due to excessive cost not covered by AIA Tournament Budget, the hospitality room is for Volunteer Official's, Timer's, and Meet Administrator's only. Sunnyslope and Desert Vista Boosters will have a concession stand open to the Public.

- Dressing rooms will be available. There are no lockers or towels provided for participants in this meet.
- Neither the AIA nor the host site is responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- In order to provide swimmers and divers with the best possible competitive environment, admission to the deck will be limited to credentialed athletes, coaches and meet officials.
  - All individual qualifiers (swimming and diving) will automatically receive credentials.
  - Alternates for individual events are listed for 5A only. These alternates will automatically receive credentials.
  - Credentials for coaches and relay-only swimmers will be based on information provided on Team Info Forms.
  - **Misuse of credentials will result in confiscation and possible ejection.**
- Boys will compete first, Girls second.
- Awards will be as noted in the AIA Constitution and Bylaws. The awards for swimming will be presented on deck during the break or at the conclusion of the swimming competition. The awards for diving will be presented in the diving area at the conclusion of each section of diving competition.
- A swimming and diving equipment vendor, TBD will be on site just outside the Mona Plummer complex on October 29, October 30. A Vendor TBD will be on site November 5th and 6th.
- State Swimming & Diving Tee Shirts may be on sale in the lobby of the Mona Plummer complex on October 29, October 30 and November 5-6. Kukulski Brothers is the official supplier for AIA Programs and Souvenirs. Playoff programs, t-shirts, caps, etc., will be available at as many sites as possible. Please call David Kukulski or Dan Kukulski at (480) 921-1975 if you have any questions regarding AIA Programs, Souvenirs, or Digital Photography.
- Concession stands may be available on October 29, October 30 and November 5-6. Food and drinks may not be taken onto the pool deck.
- Due to anticipated congestion, Tempe City Transit system will be facilitating the needs of ASU and student pick up at Mona Plummer Aquatic Center. **(5A state meet only)**
- No chairs are available. Coaches should bring their own chairs.
- No commercial tents (large rented tents installed by outside vendors) will be permitted.
- Portable non-commercial tents will be permitted.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS-DIVING**

4A Diving: The top four (4) finishers in each region shall advance to the State Championship.

5A Diving: The top seven (7) finishers in each region shall advance to the State Championship.

**PLEASE NOTE:** After three (3) dives, the 5A competitors will be reduced to 32.

### **NFHS 2003-2004 SWIMMING AND DIVING RULE BOOK: PAGE 55**

When there are more than 32 divers entered, all divers should be permitted to complete the preliminaries (5 dives). However, the sponsoring organization (AIA) has the right to reduce the field to 32 divers after three rounds. With the field thus reduced, the remaining two dives of the preliminaries are performed, followed by semifinals and finals.

Divers and coaches should pick up their credentials at the general registration table at the East entrance to the of the Mona Plummer complex. The names of diving coaches should be listed on the Team Information Forms.

Diving spectators will purchase tickets and enter through the southwest gate of the Mona Plummer complex.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS-SWIMMING**

4A Swimming: Each region champion plus the top 17 times swum in the finals of region meet, except event number five (one meter dive), where the top four will advance to the state championship in each individual event and relay. **If a contestant who qualified for the state meet is unable to participate because of illness or for any other reason, no contestant shall be certified to take his/her place in the state meet.**

5A Swimming: Each region champion plus the top 17 times swum on the second day of region competition will advance to the state championship in each individual event and relay.

***5A only: Two (2) alternates will be listed for each event and may be called to compete. Alternates will be notified of their status at the 5A coaches meeting November 5.***

***5A Coaches meeting November 5, 2004***

All 4A and 5A swimmers will enter the pool through the east gate.

### **RELAY ENTRIES**

- > **Relays at the regional qualifying tournaments shall be competed as timed final events.**
- National Federation Swimming Rule Book, 3.2.3. In relay events, 8 individuals may be designated and it shall not count as an entry unless the competitor actually competes in the event. Any of the 8 individuals may swim in the prelims, swim-offs and/or finals provided he/she does not exceed the permitted entries for the meet.
- Relay entry forms are included in this packet. Relay entry forms must be turned into the Clerk of Course (computer table) for:
  - ❑ 4A by 8:30 AM on Friday, October 29
  - ❑ 5A by 8:30 AM on Friday, November 5
  - ❑ Up to eight (8) names may be placed on each entry form.
- The swimmers for relays at the state championship are not required to be the same as those listed for regional meets.
- Designation of the actual four participants will take place not later than the conclusion of the race. The names of the four participants are to be circled on the form with the names of the relay leadoff swimmer identified to the lane timer.

## **PARKING INFORMATION**

### 4A – 5A Conference State Swimming/Diving Championships

#### ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY Tempe, Arizona

Saturday November 6, 2004 is ASU Homecoming and many streets will be closed and parking reserved for season ticket holders. There will be no parking near Mona Plummer Aquatic Complex.

The City of Tempe Transit bus system has identified the following Park and Ride Locations:

- Traveling north on I-10: Park at Costco Park-N-Ride (Elliot and Priest) Take route 56 Priest northbound to downtown Tempe. Drop off point will be near 6<sup>th</sup> and College.
- Traveling West or east on US 60: Park at Mervyns Park-N-Ride (Southern and Rural) Take route 72 – Rural/Scottsdale northbound to downtown Tempe. Drop off point will be near 6<sup>th</sup> and College.
- Traveling from Scottsdale or west or east on Loop 202: Park at Big Lots Park-N-Ride (McKellips and Scottsdale) Take route 72 – Scottsdale/Rural southbound to downtown Tempe. Drop off point will be near 6<sup>th</sup> and College.
- Park at Tempe High School and take routes 65 – Mill/Kyrene northbound, 66-Mill/68<sup>th</sup> Street northbound or 92- 48<sup>th</sup> Street Guadalupe northbound to downtown Tempe. Drop off point will be near 6<sup>th</sup> and College.
- Tempe High School will have a shuttle bus operating from the Broadway Blvd. parking lot departing every 20 minutes starting at 12:00 noon until 2:00 PM. The shuttle bus will start again at 3:30 PM from the drop off area until last bus departure at 4:30 PM.
- Drop off points are 6<sup>th</sup> and College for routes 65 & 92 and 5<sup>th</sup> and College for route 66.
- **COST:** \$1.25 each way for adults 19 to 64.  
65 cents for people 6 to 18 and 65 over.  
Free for kids under 6
- Frequency for these routes varies. Most buses run every 30 minutes on Saturday except route 65, which runs every hour. Visit [www.valleymetro.org](http://www.valleymetro.org) for bus schedules
