## RULES

Rules shall be those of the current National Federation Wrestling Rule Book with exceptions noted in the AIA Constitution and Bylaws and these tournament instructions.

**2011-12 NFHS Wrestling Rule 1-5-2 (page 8)** - Any wrestler's assessment that is below seven percent for males and 12 percent of females shall have a physician's release to participate. This release shall not allow a wrestler to participate at a weight class below that for which the initial assessment allows.

**AIA Bylaw 31.1.5 (page 121)** - Weight loss may not be more than 1.5% of the "alpha" weight (weight at time of certification) per week. Wrestler will follow the prescribed weight loss process of the NWCA weight certification model ([nwcaonline.com](http://nwcaonline.com)).

**DETERMINATION:** Coaches or their designee (athletic director of school assessor) **MUST** print out a weigh-in sheet for every weigh-in their school participates in for the AIA wrestling season. It is required that each school present minimally two copies of their weigh-in sheets at weigh-ins, one for themselves and one for each opponent. In events of multiple schools, multiple copies of this sheet must be made available for each opponent. No wrestling may occur until the team can produce an NWCA Performance Calculator weigh-in sheet. A school cannot deny an opponent or visiting schools from using their computer system to access the NWCA Performance Calculator if they so request. (Ex. Bd. 10/19/09)

**AIA Bylaw 31.1.6 (page 121); Certification Data** – A wrestler must have certified his lowest competitive weight before representing a school in any wrestling match.

- Weight certification may begin Oct. 31, 2011, as determined by the AIA Executive Board.

**AIA Bylaw 31.1.7 (page 121); Growth Allowance** - A two-pound growth allowance will take effect on Jan. 1, 2012.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- **WEIGH IN INSTRUCTIONS:** The participating school buses will need to park in the Northwest parking lot and the wrestlers will need to check-in the double doors on the North-West side of the arena.
- The meet officials are responsible for the conduct of the meet as prescribed by playing rules adopted by the AIA.
- Each wrestler is required to be in full uniform from the time the participant steps on the mat until the end of the match.
- Weigh-in will follow Rule 4, Section 5, and pp: 18 & 19, of the 2011/2012 National Federation Wrestling Rule Book.
- All wrestlers must be checked for skin condition prior to weigh-in. The NFHS Sports Medicine Advisory Committee has provided a physical release form for wrestlers to participate with skin lesion. Form attached with this tournament guide. AIA recommends the doctor evaluating any skin lesion be a dermatologist. This form must be completed prior to weigh-in or upon arrival at the site of dual meet and/or tournament. ***Please Review NFHS Wrestling Rules 4.2.4, page 17.***
- All meet personnel, other than officials; will be assigned by the Tournament Director.

- It is recommended that a doctor, EMT personnel or Certified Athletic Trainer, and a vehicle for emergency transportation be available.
- A coach must be in attendance during all warm-up sessions.
- ***Coaches and wrestlers not participating in a match at Tim's Toyota Center must be off the competition floor area.***
- Neither the AIA nor the school of the host site shall be responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Any coach or competitor using tobacco, alcoholic beverages or misusing drugs while at the tournament site during an athletic contest sponsored by AIA, shall be disqualified from that contest or tournament. AIA Constitution and Bylaws, Article 14: Section 14.12.1, DRUGS, ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, page 35.

### **TOURNAMENT SIGNS/ARTIFICIAL NOISEMAKERS/TRIPODS**

- Signs are not permitted at any indoor tournament sponsored by the AIA. (AIA Bylaw 12.1.5) Artificial noisemakers are prohibited at state playoff venues. If any artificial noisemaker is brought into a game site, the item will be confiscated. Disruptive/unsportsmanlike behavior by spectators will not be tolerated. Violators will be removed from the venue.

**Video Cameras:** Video cameras will be allowed in the facility. However, videotaping must be done from the seats – you may not go onto the floor or stand in areas that will block traffic or obstruct view. **Tripods will not be allowed.** Please note that electrical outlets will not be available for charging video camera batteries or for the purpose of operation. Therefore, it is important that this be done before arrival to the tournament site.

### **AWARDS**

#### **Sectionals:**

Each sectional will award both team Champion and Runner-up plaques. Individual medals will be awarded for places **1 through 4** in all 14 weight classes.

#### **State Tournament:**

Each Division will award both team Champion and Runner-up trophies. Individual medals will be awarded for places **1 through 6** in all 14 weight classes.

## **SPORTSMANSHIP**

- If an athlete or coach is ejected, the Sportsmanship Rule will be in effect. (See the AIA Constitution and Bylaws, Article 16. Section 16.3, pages 53-54). National Federation Rule 8 (penalty chart) pages 42-43.
- Part of sportsmanship is following directions given by tournament workers.

## **AUTHORIZED SCHOOL PERSONNEL MAT-SIDE**

- No wrestler is permitted on the wrestling floor except when participating in a match.
  - On-Deck participants must remain off the wrestling arena until the match they follow is over.
- Only two coaches, wearing an official coach's wristband/credentials, are permitted mat side. A coach with current session wristband/credentials will be allowed with an on-deck wrestler in the holding area. *Violation of this rule will result in a loss of one team point and/or coaches floor pass privilege removed.*

## **PROTESTS**

1. Cannot appeal judgment: NFHS Rule 3.1.2, page 12.
2. Correction of Error: NFHS Rule 6.6.3 & 4, page 32 & 33.
3. Protests/appeal will be reviewed by the Head Official or his designee and 2 members of the tournament games committee prior to the start of any subsequent period.
4. A loss of appeal will result in a one-point team score deduction.

## **OFFICIALS**

AIA registered certified officials will be used to officiate. Officials will be assigned by the State Commissioner of Officials.

## **OFFICIAL CLOCK OPERATOR (MAT SIDE)**

AIA officials will be used at all tournament matches.

## **MAT-SIDE SCORES TABLE**

The following may be seated at the individual conference head tables:

- Official timer, Troubleshooter, Official scorer, Runners, and the AIA Rotating mat official



**SECTIONAL & STATE SEEDING CRITERIA ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Sectional Seeding Criteria**

1. The Sectional Tournament will seed to six (6) places
2. Pre-seeding will be determined by each wrestler's OVERALL season winning %.  
(wrestler must have wrestled a MINIMUM of (7) seven matches to be seeded)
3. Returnig previous year Arizona State Champion
4. Head to Head Competition will determine final seeding positions. (not just a tie-breaker)

Note: The wrestling round to determine a true second has been eliminated.

**State Tournament Seeding Criteria**

The following seeding criteria will be used for all Divisions of the State Wrestling Tournaments.

1. The State Tournament will seed to nine (9) places
2. The top three (3) sectional placers will be placed into a nine (9) man pool for seeding consideration
3. Sectional Champions will always receive a higher seed than their respective Runner-ups regardless to Head to Head competition.
4. Pre-seeding will be determined by each wrestler's OVERALL season winning %.
5. Returning previous year Arizona State Champion
6. Head to head competition will determine final seeding (exception #2)
7. Seeding criteria for the 16<sup>th</sup> slot in the bracket will be:  
(6<sup>th</sup> place in sectional, overall win %, head to head competition)

Please download the AIA Media Credential Form and should a media member need access that is not on the media list, they will need to sign off on the form. Please print out several of the Media Credential Forms so each media outlet fills out its own form. Should the media member refuse to sign off on the form, they will not be granted access to the region or state tournament event you're hosting.

At the conclusion of the event, please fax or mail those forms to the AIA so that we may follow up and credential those people the approved media list will be updated as forms are received and processed. Please download the AIA Approved Media List and AIA School Media List (which is constantly being updated) so that those members of the media that are already approved may be granted access. Please note that some members of the media might show up with Freelance Credentials. These have no pictures on them, but do allow for access to the event per the designated media outlet on the AIA Media Credential.

### FLOOR ADMITTANCE

Each school with wrestlers competing at Tim's Toyota Center will receive a maximum of four credential ID's.(Wrist Bands) This credential ID allows admittance to the floor area. The credential can be picked up at the Credential table. ***Each school must send the AIA a list of four board-approved coaches PRIOR TO Jan. 27, 2012.*** . All coaches, wrestlers, Certified Athletic Trainers, and school support mat-maids must have the current wrist band per session to be admitted to the arena. All other coaches, eliminated tournament wrestlers, certified athletic trainer and school support mat-maids must have the appropriate session to be admitted to the arena.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- **Concessions** – Concession stands will be available at all High School sites with proceeds accruing to the host concessionaire
- **Trophies** – Awards will be as noted in the AIA Constitution and Bylaws
- **Ice Chests/Food/Etc.** – Each TEAM will be allowed ONE cooler to include fruit, vegetables, granola & power bars, homemade sandwiches, water & Gatorades type products.
- **Hospitality Room** – There is **NO** coaches hospitality room at high school sectional's or Tim's Toyota Center! Please make your own arrangements.
