> FOOTBALL SPORTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE (Time Slade)

- Discussed proposal from Football Sports Advisory Committee in limiting football games to be more consistent by (<u>Bylaw 23.5</u>) removing the term "unlimited."
- Football Sports Advisory Committee proposes that all Divisions adopt the 50% rule.
- Divisions 4, 5 & 6 will reduce the JV Schedules to 8 games (for JV and Freshman)
- Division 6 will play their JV games on Tuesday instead of Thursdays.
 - o Eliminate 23.5.3.1 and replace it by adding Divisions 5 & 6 and eliminate example and add "Varsity" at 'to participate in 50% more <u>varsity</u> games than...'
 - Motioned by Dr. Kwasnica 2nd by Mark Strom. All approved the motion with the amendment.

NATUROPATHIC PHYSICIS PERFORMING PRE-PARTICIPATION PHYSICALS (Dr. Mark Strom)

- Dr. Mark Strom presented a document with the background and proposal.
 - o Motioned by John Parsons 2nd by Dr. Kwasnica.

- Amendment to change language from "traditional healthcare provider" to the MD, DO language in the AIA Bylaws.
- AIA recognizes pre-participation physical examinations by Naturopathic Physicians.
- One year observation, 2014-2015 school year, to assess preparticipation physicals and recommendations performed by NDs. NDs would refer patients with abnormal preparticipation physical findings to an allopathic or osteopathic physician during the initial year
- Amendment to remove the third option.
 - Motion is approved.

➤ ATC PRESENCE AT GAMES (Ron Kordonowy)

- Post season games require licensed ATCs or appropriate healthcare professional at the games.
- Concern is with the regular season games (Cost and availability)
- Only 15% of regular season games are covered with ATCs or appropriate healthcare professionals.
- The AIA Staff has been directed to bring information about what contact sports this would affect to the January SMAC Meeting for review.

<u>NWCA WEIGHT MANAGEMNT (Dean Visser & Ron Kordonowy)</u>

- Dean Visser discussed the issues with the current weight management process and possible solutions.
 - o Handout
- Standard mode vs Athletic Mode.
 - o Standard Mode to be more accurate.
- Eliminate Alternative and update 31.1.4.1 with the standard mode verbiage.
- Bylaw 31
- The Committee requested for Dean Visser and Ron Kordonowy to make the changes and bring back to the Committee for review in January.
