

For Parents that are attending the 2020 State Cross Country meet:

Division One and Three: Thursday. November 12, 2020

Division Two and Four: Friday. November 13, 2020

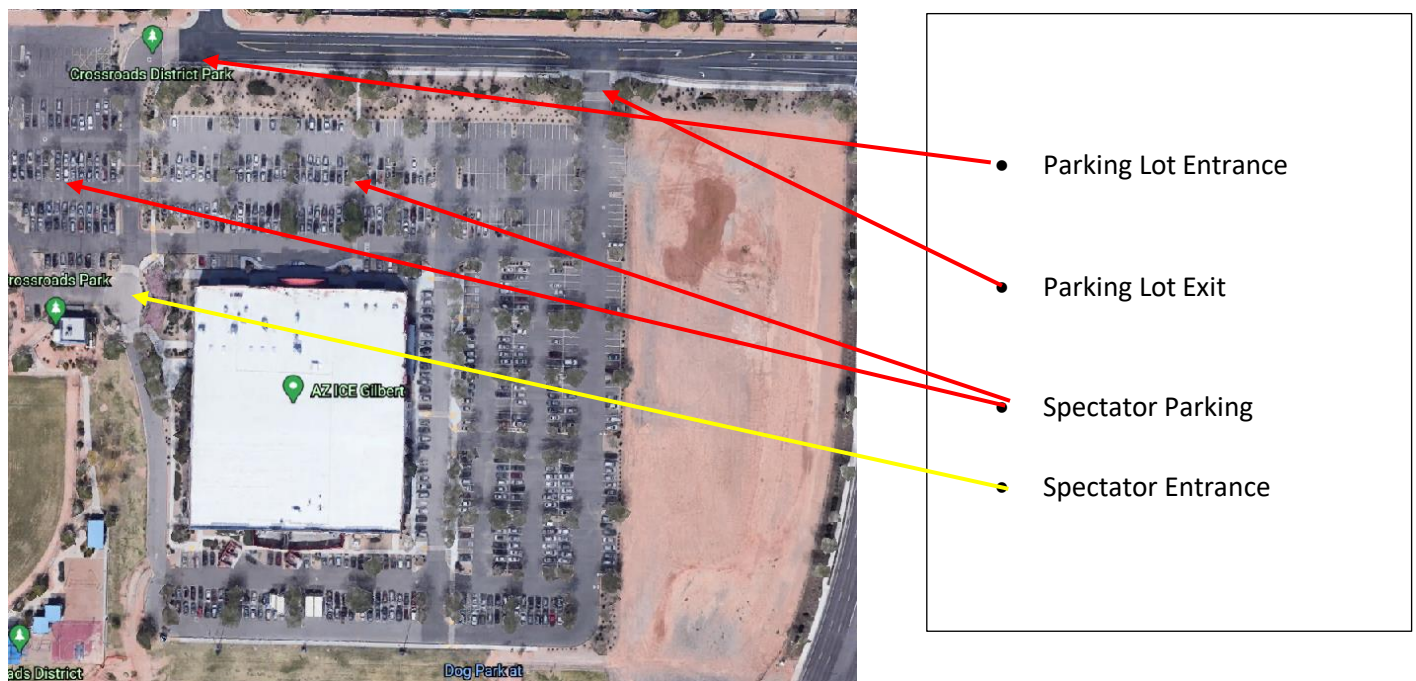
Each athlete will receive two wrist bands that are for spectators. They will be either Green or Orange depending on the day of their state cross country meet. Each wrist band will cost \$10 and monies will need to be paid to the coach or the school. Check with the coach how they wish to receive this money.

There are NO additional spectator wrist bands at the park. When you park at Cross Roads Park (2155 E. Knox Road) you will need to have your wrist band on before entering the course area. Please do not attempt or try to bring additional guests with you. We are held to strict attendance mandates and Gilbert was good enough to increase the limitations to allow two spectators per athlete.

Spectators can be down in the lower bowl area—where the finish and starting line are—but they must stay north of the barricade security fencing. Competitors will pass this area twice as well coming into the finish line. Spectators can also be in the upper field level if they wish.

There will be no concession stand, but there is a restaurant located in the Arizona Ice Rink that will be open.
