RE: 2023-24 Girls Wrestling

I am sending this memorandum on behalf of the Wrestling Sports Advisory Committee of the Arizona Interscholastic Association ("AIA") regarding girls wrestling. Girls wrestling has expanded rapidly during the past few years. While this is excellent, such fast progress places additional demands on schools, athletic directors, and coaches. The purpose of this memorandum is to assist with the workload and ensure you are: (1) informed of the changes, and (2) assist with scheduling to ensure all schools and athletes have opportunities to wrestle without undue burdens on the student athletes' time and the school's budget.

I. Divisions and Sections.

<u>Divisions.</u> The biggest change is that girls wrestling now has two divisions as set forth in **Attachment p. 1**. The divisions were set based upon the following objective criteria:

- All wrestling Boys Division 1 schools remain in Girls Division 1.
- All Boys Division 2 schools remain in Girls Division 1 unless:
 - The school did not qualify a girl for state last year and did not qualify a girl for the state in either 2021 or 2022. These schools were placed in Girls Division 2.
- All Boys Division 3 and 4 schools are in Girls Division 2.

<u>Sections</u>. The sections are shown in **Attachment p. 2 (Div. 1) and p. 3 (Div. 2**). Sections were set based upon the objective criteria. First, the strongest schools were identified to ensure no section has four or five powerhouse programs, which hinders growth of the other sectional teams and can hinder strong schools as the road to state becomes far more challenging. Second, sections were divided based upon school locations. Third, there was an attempt to keep schools in the same district to be in the same section. With very few exceptions, the sections are predominantly based upon geographic location. In other words, only a few schools were moved from one section to another section to achieve balance.

II. Scheduling Sectional Meets.

One of the biggest concerns with the emergence of girls wrestling has been: (1) giving the athletes enough opportunities to wrestle; (2) avoiding undue expense; and (3) most important, ensuring travel and matches can occur without running late on school nights. Therefore, we have created a "sectional meets" schedule that brings many schools together at one centralized location on



a Tuesday night. See Attachment p. 4. Based upon a statistical analysis using 2022 participation numbers, participating girls should be able to wrestle three times and finish by 8:00 pm. In fact, we will have a rule that no match starts after 8:00 pm so even teams that travel will get home at a decent time and be ready for school the next day. These sectional meet dates are as follows:

- November 28, 2023 weigh-in 3:00 pm ends 8:00 pm;
- December 5, 2023 weigh-in 3:00 pm ends 8:00 pm; and
- January 9, 2023 weigh-in 3:00 pm ends 8:00 pm.

To implement this system, we have divided each section into three regions (A, B, C) and set up a round-robin schedule in which every team will wrestle against every other team in its section as well as an intersectional group of teams. See Attachment p. 2 (Div. 1) and p. 3 (Div. 2). Suggested meet sites are below the team sections and regions chart. These sites have been selected because they are centrally located. These are just suggestions, however, and the sections will need to finalize the location, dates, and times. If an event needs to be moved, consider moving to Monday of that week or to a nearby school on Tuesday. In addition, to assist the host school, we will be providing a match creation system that can be readily used to ensure the events run smoothly and on time.

III. Girls Wrestling Boys.

AIA Rule 14.11.6 states "whenever a school provides a team(s) for boys and a team(s) for girls in the same sport, girls shall not be permitted to qualify for the boys' team(s) in that sport...." The rule will be applied this year. Thus, girls cannot participate in boys' wrestling events this year. This includes tournaments and dual meets. Recognizing there are a handful of extremely talented girl wrestlers, if a girl seeks to wrestle on the boys' team, the school may petition the AIA on the girl's behalf for a waiver of this rule and allow these girls to wrestle on the boys' team. But if the petition is granted, then the petitioning girl cannot wrestle on the girls' team or compete in the girls' sectional or state tournaments.

IV. Seeding for Sectionals.

In previous years, there has been an issue with girls receiving very high seeds at sectional tournaments even though they wrestled only a few matches but received numerous forfeits, which count as wins. To alleviate this issue, beginning this season a girl must wrestle a minimum of seven (7) times in actual matches to be considered for seeding at sectionals. Forfeits do not count to meet this "actual match" criteria. However, if the athlete has met this criteria, then forfeits do count as part of her winning percentage.

V. Girls Team Duals.

Another issue needing consistent application are team dual records. A contest between two girls' wrestling teams consists of six or more actual matches. Otherwise, the match results should be entered individually. This is an issue to be addressed by the head coaches and more information will be provided to these coaches prior to the beginning of the season so results can be entered in a consistent manner.
