## SEEDING CRITERIA:

1. Minimum of 7 matches. Forfeits do NOT count to meet the minimum number of matches but will count to the overall record if the wrestler has 7 actual matches or more.
2. Returning Arizona State Placers (Previous Year)
3. OVERALL Season Win \% (multiple undefeated wrestlers with no other criteria, then the higher seed goes to the MOST wins)
4. Trackwrestling will take into account all common opponents to determine seeding positions.
5. Head-to-Head will Supersede \#1, \#3, and \#4

MATCH TIMES: Championship matches 2-2-2, consolation matches 1-2-2
OFFICIALS: AIA Officials will be assigned to the tournament
AWARDS: Medals for top FOUR placers, Sectional Championship Team Award. The top 4 placers qualify for the AIA State Tournament.
