Directions For Buses:	Take Deer Valley Road from either Tatum Blvd or Cave Creek Road to Black Mountain Blvd. Turn south on Black Mountain Blvd. DO NOT USE THE BLACK MOUNTAIN EXIT FROM THE S.R. 51, because that would cause the buses to make a u-turn to get to the bus lane entrance. Team Arrival:	Buses will travel south on Black Mountain Blvd. to the last entrance on the right at the racquetball courts. Proceed down the bus lane past the football stadium and park in the bus lane on the north side next to the E Building. The team will go into the E Building. Format:	 16-man bracket – Double Elimination (may be reduced to 8-man bracket) Championship matches 2-2-2 Consolation matches 1-2-2 		
Team Scoring:	 1st Place - 14 points 2nd Place - 10 points 3rd Place - 7 points 4th Place - 4 points 		
Awards:	 Medals awarded to top 4 places Sectional Championship Team Award All medals will be handed out after the Heavyweight match and the Champions Photo. 		
Coaches (Wristbands)	Each team will be given 4 wristbands for coaches (head & 3 assistants). Only athletes and officials will be allowed on the floor WITHOUT a wristband		
Hospitality Room & Concessions	 Pinnacle's Wrestling Booster Club will provide food and drinks for coaches, officials and workers only. Concessions will be available to wrestlers and spectators
