## AIA SECTIONAL CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS THURSDAY, November 6, 2025

#### Location:

Crossroads Park, Gilbert, Arizona. Crossroads Park is located at Greenfield Road and Knox between Ray and Warner Road.

#### Directions:

<u>From Tucson</u>: Take I-10 to loop 202 east bound. Exit at San Tan Village Road and turn left (heading north-west) Travel approximately 2.5 miles. The park entrance will be on your left, at the light for Knox Road.

<u>From Phoenix:</u> Take the Superstition (US60) Freeway east bound. Exit Greenfield Road and turn right (heading south). Head south approximately 3 miles. Park entrance will be on your right, at the light for Knox Road.

## <u>Awards:</u>

Medals will be awarded to the top fourteen (14) individuals in each sectional race.

The top team will receive a Sectional Championship Plaque.

This will be a full day of racing. Athletes need to report to the starting line check in as a full team. Athletes also must be race ready. Check in begins 20 minutes before the start of each race.



#### Course:

The course is grass, granite, dirt and some concrete and asphalt. Copy of the map is at the end of this packet. Make copies of the map as there will be none at the coaches meeting or in the coaches' packet. NO SPIKES are allowed to be worn. This includes "spikeless" shoes that have spikes as part of the sole of the shoe. NOR are bikes allowed to be ridden by coaches or those affiliated with a team.

AIA Bylaws state that NO team or individual may practice on the championship course within seven (7) days of the meet. With the exception being if the course is a home course for a team.

This year the location of the starting line and the finish line are switched. This should prevent any crossing problem between a race start and a slower finisher from the race prior.

### Section Entry Procedure:

Each team must designate up to seven runners. Entries are to be submitted online at www.athletic.net

Entry deadline is Monday, November 3, 2025 by 8:00 AM. Changes to your entries will be allowed at check in

#### State Qualification:

The top 1/2 of full teams scores will advance to the state meet. Thus, if ten (10) teams have a team score, then five (5) teams will advance to state. IF there is an odd number, the next number up for advancement will go. Thus, if eleven (11) teams have a team score then six (6) teams will advance.

The top seven (7) individuals from the teams NOT advancing will advance to state. Thus every section will have seven individuals that will advance to the state meet.
